


Combo Tees Score Entry – NCGA Smartphone App

To enter your score for the new Combo Tees at Ancil Hoffman in the GHIN app on your smart phone you will need to open the NCGA app on your phone. The following images are from an Android phone but should be similar for iPhones as well.

After starting the NCGA app it should look like this:



Click the link to 'POST SCORE'.

After clicking on 'POST SCORE' you will see the following page:
