Midweek Tournament Chairman

Hello Ancil Hoffman Golf Club Members!

The three Midweek Tournaments in October, November and December 2016 had outstanding turnouts, with 122 players in the October 13 Individual Stroke, 142 players in the November 17 Member/Guest 2 Person Best Ball, and 110 players in the December 22 Skins Game.

The October 13 tournament flight winners were Donn Pintar, Sean O'Dowd, Ross Wallace and Gerry Steyn. The November 17 tournament flight winners were the Gary Bradley/Skip Jahn team, the Sid Gauthreaux/Mike Gerbec team, and the Robert Slockbower/Dave Riddle team. The December 22 tournament had 99 players with skin money, with top winners being Gary Bradley, Gerry Steyn, Peter Deacon, Robert Slockbower, Alex Washington, and Mike Payne.

There were a few changes implemented earlier in the year for the Midweek Tournaments, including increasing the tournament fee to \$20, and creating a hole in one jackpot of \$1,500 when the hole in one fund exceeds that amount.

There will be a few enhancements to the Midweek Tournament schedule for 2017. There will be an away tournament on March 23 at the Auburn Valley Golf Course. There will be a separate member/guest tournament on Wednesday, October 25. There will be a "winter series championship", wherein, the player with the lowest aggregate net score for three of the first four midweek tournaments will be awarded \$250 (no tiebreakers, prize might be shared), and there will be a similar "summer series championship" for the four tournaments in late May through August.

I want to thank all participants for making the Midweek Tournaments run smoothly. Please remember to enter on-line early, as typically the tournaments become full and registration ends 7-10 days beforehand. In addition, please note that there is a 48 hour cancellation policy that is in effect for all Midweek Tournaments.

Welcome to the 2017 AHGC Weekend Tournament Season!

We've got three events in the first quarter and looking for participation stay hot as it did much of 2016, please keep up the enthusiasm and be sure to let me know if there is anything else I can do to help keep the tournaments a success.

Coming up in February and March, we will have our two separate NCGA qualifiers for both the 4-Ball and Zone Championships. These are both 2person, Best Ball formats, but do I have a slight difference. The 4-Ball event requires that both partners be within 8 strokes of their handicaps, while the Zone Championship does not. The March event will be 2 days (March 11 and March 18) for those that want to participate in the NCGA portion. I will be taking approximately the top 5 or 6 groups per flight (A & B), to determine who will advance to Monterey. I am experimenting again this year to see if spreading out the two day event across two weekends will help with the participation numbers.

Many thanks go out to Matt Jones, Pat Harold, and John Mars for their volunteer hours and allowing me to leave the course at a decent time. Hit 'em straight, keep up the pace, and have fun. The last being the most important part, this is a public golf club intended for recreational purposes after all! Many of us could have it a heck of a lot worse than to be able to come out a beautiful golf course once or twice a month to try our hand at competitive golf.

The United States Golf Association (USGA) has adopted a new local rule effective 1/1/2017. The USGA has asked all clubs that make competitions to discuss and adopt or reject the local rule. The Board of Directors for Ancil Hoffman Golf Club has discussed this rule and has voted to adopt the USGA local rule. The local rule addresses accidental movement of a player's ball on the putting green, the Dustin Johnson rule.

NEW LOCAL RULE FOR ALL ANCIL HOFFMAN GOLF CLUB TOURNAMENTS

effective January 1, 2017

Accidental Movement of a Ball on a Putting Green

Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1 are modified as follows:

When a player's ball lies on the putting green, there is no penalty if the ball or ball-marker is accidentally moved by the player, his partner, his opponent, or any of their caddies or equipment.

The moved ball or ball-marker must be replaced as provided in Rules 18-2, 18-3 and 20-1.

This Local Rule applies only when the player's ball or ball-marker lies on the putting green and any movement is accidental.

Note: If it is determined that a player's ball on the putting green was moved as a result of wind, water or some other natural cause such as the effects of gravity, the ball must be played as it lies from its new location. A ball-marker moved in such circumstances is replaced.
